### Dear Students and Parents:

Welcome to the first quarter. **Classes are held at 2201 South Oneida St.** (in the Heid Music building). The building is on the corner of Oneida and Marvelle, two blocks south of the Packer practice field. Enter the building on the Marvelle (north) side -- the first door to the left of the Heid music entrance. (The Gordon School of Art Logo is on the window next to the door.) Follow the hallway (there are four turns) to the classroom (it is off the general purpose room.)
